

ENGLISH 12

Grade: 12 (College Prep)

Credit: 0.5 or 1.0 (NCAA approved)

Prerequisites: English 9-11

The course focuses on the reading and analysis of literature, development of writing skills, expansion of vocabulary, and enhancement of critical thinking skills. Students are exposed to the different genres through both reading and writing. It emphasizes essay writing in different styles and for different audiences to establish good writing skills. Students edit their work for content and for errors in sentence structure, usage, mechanics, and spelling. They read and critique canonical works, works of their own choosing, as well as studying works across different genres. They engage in research processes and documentation techniques. By the end of the course, students will have improved their reading, writing, research, critical thinking, and communication skills.
