Whitmore School's mastery learning approach offers students the freedom and responsibility of self-paced learning. Students are accountable for mastering all the skills and content of each lesson. Students submit revisions of their work until the instructor determines that the student has a genuine understanding of the concepts in the lesson. In the process, students also master important life skills such as time-management, effective communication, independence, and responsibility.

In 2005, CompuHigh Whitmore School became regionally accredited by NCA-CASI (now Cognia) in recognition of the excellent education we provide to students.
